Are there any guideline about the meline from this award along the transla onal spectrum

The program guidelines specify the research should be ear term". We realize this can take some me. Proposals should avoid the beginning/early stages, which are more aligned with basic research. A meline of away from dinical research is appropriate and can be pointed out in the proposal.

I am interestatsure your proposal provides ra onale and cites literature for the model (s) hydrocose, research has proper controls in place, and that clinical endpoints align clearly with human relevant clinical endpoints.

Could research be proposed involving compounds not yet in use for trea ng AD?
