Frequently Asked Questions (updated 11.13.24)

May an organization on one grant also be part of another grant submission?

Yes, an organization can be part of multiple grant submissions. However, the PI must be the same for all submissions.

If an organization is offered the Award but cannot accept it, may it be transferred to one of the partner organizations significantly involved in the project?

No, the Award cannot be transferred to another organization.

If I apply and do not receive an Award, may I apply in future years?

Yes, you may re-apply in future years. However, you must wait at least one year after a non-award before re-applying.

I received a Jeffress Trust Award in a past cycle; may I apply for a second Award?

Yes, you may apply for a second Award. However, you must wait at least one year after the end of your first award before re-applying.

If the planning phase doesn't require two years, can the PI apply for research funding to begin after just one year of planning?

Yes, you may apply for research funding to begin after just one year of planning. However, you must wait at least one year after the end of your planning phase before re-applying.

Is the project budget subject to the NIH salary cap requirements for academic personnel?

Yes, the project budget is subject to the NIH salary cap requirements for academic personnel.

If I receive a grant through the Jeffress Trust Awards will it be possible to apply for a renewal?

Yes, you may apply for a renewal. However, you must wait at least one year after the end of your grant before re-applying.

Past Jeffress Trust Awards have had a limit on the number of nominations per organization. Does this still apply?

Yes, the limit on the number of nominations per organization still applies.

Can a principal investigator who is currently working on a grant funded by Jeffress apply for any of these grants if it is a new project?

Yes, a PI can apply for a new grant if it is a new project. However, they must wait at least one year after the end of their current grant before re-applying.

Should the 15% indirect be included in the total \$600K/\$150K or is it in addition to that?

- Indirect costs are included in the total \$600K/\$150K
- Indirect costs are in addition to that

Where do I provide a description and role of my organization in the application?

- In the "Organization Information" section of the application
- In the "Budget Narrative" section of the application

To whom should letters of partnership/commitment be addressed?

- To the Principal Investigator

Can any letters be sent separately?

- No, all letters must be included in the application PDF

May I include appendices with the Proposal?

- Yes, appendices are allowed and should be included in the application PDF

May I include a cover letter in the uploaded PDF?

- No, a cover letter is not required and should not be included in the application PDF

Are the page limits listed in the guidelines for the proposal narrative section strict or are they suggested lengths?

- The page limits are strict and must be followed

Additional Questions

Is "general research" only supported through obtaining a Research Award or is this also a subcategory of the 2-year, Partnership/Collaborative Establishment Award?

- "General research" is supported through both the Research Award and the Partnership/Collaborative Establishment Award
